Exultation of the Holy Cross This year the feast of the Exultation of the Holy Cross is on a Sunday, and so it is raised to the dignity of a full solemnity. It's also the Title Day of the Church of the Holy Cross at Aberaeron! So that the people of Aberaeron can more fully celebrate their day, the Mass times of Aberaeron and Lampeter have been swapped around just for the occasion. Please do keep the people of Aberaeron in your payers on this day. Also, pray for the community of the Cistercian Nuns of the Strict Observance at their Monastery of the Holy Cross at Whitland.

Bathroom Facilities at Lampeter I'm sorry to have to say that the bathroom at Lampeter has had to close owing to safety requirements. The bathroom is no longer to be used. The diocesan health and safety officer is coming to Lampeter this week to inspect the premises. It is regrettable that no facilities can now be provided on the church property, however there are some public facilities in town and in Sainsbury's Supermarket.

Evening for Readers/Eucharistic Ministers. For those who have the ministry of reading in scriptures in our parishes, there will be an evening for readers on Tuesday 16th September at 6:00pm to 7:30pm. The following week, on 23rd September, there will be an evening for those who are Eucharistic Ministers. These evenings will look at giving some updates as to how we undertake this ministry. On the 4th October from 11:30am both groups will have some time together for a time of input and reflection followed by a commissioning service. The Church askes that all those who undertake a ministry should be commissioned for a set period of time – generally one year. As such, readers and ministers will be commissioned on an annual basis. Those who haven't been commissioned should not undertake a ministry until this has happened. If you are not able to attend the sessions please do email Fr Liam so that alternative arrangements can be made later in the year.

Christian Aid Lunch This lunch supports World Food Outreach – an initiative of the United Nations' World Food Programme. This lunch happens on the first Friday of each month from 12noon to 1:30pm at St Peter's Church Hall, Lampeter. Provision for the lunch comes from various local churches/groups and, on Friday 3rd October, it's the Catholic Church's turn to support this endeavour. We therefore need volunteers on 3rd October as our Church hasn't contributed to the lunch since the pandemic. We need cooks, waiters, drinks makers, table layers and dish washers etc, to provide a two-course meal (meet and veggie option) for between 50 and 60 persons. Volunteers will need to arrive for 10:30am, and some things can be prepared beforehand at home (beef stew, trifle, apple pie etc).
