

Facilities at Lampeter - UPDATE I'm sorry to have to say that the bathroom at Lampeter has close owing to safety requirements. The bathroom is no longer to be used. The diocesan health and safety officer has now also been to inspect the premises (church and presbytery), and we await his report. With immediate effect, and following his advice, the gallery of the Church must also now also close. This is because the staircase is not suitable for use owing to its non-standard construction which doesn't enable safe evacuation in the event of an incident, such as a fire. I have been asked to update the diocesan insurance provider with a report and photographs of the presbytery, which I did on Wednesday evening.

Those who haven't been commissioned should not undertake a ministry until this has happened. If you are not able to attend the sessions please do email Fr Liam or Fr Malachy so that alternative arrangements can be made later in the year.

Christian Aid Lunch This lunch supports World Food Outreach – an initiative of the United Nations' World Food Programme. This lunch happens on the first Friday of each month from 12noon to 1:30pm at St Peter's Church Hall, Lampeter.
