
WELSH MARTYRS' FEAST DAY This is normally on the 25th October but, because it's the parish solemnity, it's moving to Sunday 26th October. This day is also listed as an event in the diocesan Jubilee Year calendar for events across Cardiff-Menevia. Therefore, this day will be one of particular celebration, especially at the 10:30am Mass. We will have a procession of the relics of St David Lewis (weather depending) and we will listen to 6 short biographies of the martyrs' lives. There will be time for personal veneration of the relic too.
